Opportunity For Year 9, 10, 11 and 12 Students to go to Japan.

I am writing to inform you about an exciting opportunity for your son/daughter to participate in an exchange with a Japanese school. The trip in autumn 2015 will include visits to Tokyo and to a town called Hamamatsu in Shizuoka prefecture, approximately 4 hours south of Tokyo. In Tokyo we are planning to stay for 3 nights in the National Olympics Memorial Youth Centre (NYC), a youth education centre in the heart of Tokyo. In Tokyo we will spend a few days sightseeing, including a full-day excursion to Tokyo Disneyland. After Tokyo, the remainder of the trip is planned as an exchange with Konan High School in Hamamatsu. Hendon students will stay with Japanese students from the school and their families and spend their time at school involved in a huge variety of exciting cultural activities.

We are proposing to leave on **Wednesday 21st October 2015** and return on **Monday 2nd November 2015**. Most of the trip will take place over the half term, but the students will miss four days of school. The approximate cost of the trip will be in the region of **£1,100**.

We have 2 places left on the trip this year and as a result we are opening the trip up to current Year 9s, 10s, 11s and 12s. You do not need to be studying Japanese or to have taken GCSE Japanese in order for your son/daughter to go on the trip. However, if you are in current Year 11 or 12, you must be continuing your education at Hendon School in the 2015-2016 school year in order to qualify for the trip.
