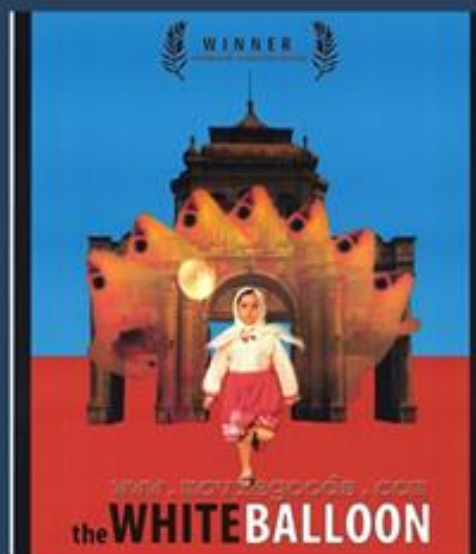

Welch issues rallying call as Hendon enter make-or-break fortnight

With all 5 of Hendon's football teams still in the hunt to claim a top 4 finish and progress to the February play-offs, Director of Football Edward Welch has issued the following rallying call: 'It is a huge couple of weeks for Hendon football, with no stone being left unturned in our pursuit of play-off Football. The teams are as well-prepared as they have ever been and I have complete faith in all of the backroom staff and players. It is exciting times for the club and I truly believe that this is the season in which we can bring some silverware home to Hendon.'

Welch has led by example this season with his Year 9 squad winning 3 of their 4 league fixtures so far this campaign. Electric centre forward Dion has been in terrific form, with his 10 league goals helping Hendon to emphatic 10-1, 6-2 and 4-0 victories over Archers, Christ College and TTA respectively. Welch will be hoping to oversee victories over Mill Hill and London Academy before heading into what could be a title decider against St James in the final week of the season. With key defender Charlie Heritage returning to match fitness, fans are optimistic that the Year 9 squad can confirm their place in the play offs this week away at London Academy.

Despite suffering penalty-shootout heartbreak at the hands of East Barnet in the cup, Richardson's Year 8 squad are still aiming for the league title having also won 3 of their 4 league games. Richardson will be hoping his squad can consolidate their top 4 position this week when they visit London Academy; a fixture which produced a memorable 7-1 victory for Hendon in the 2014/15 campaign. With Hendon's forward line of Jake, Eugene and Mustafa having caused huge problems for some of the best defensive units that the Borough has had to offer so far this season, excitement is building amongst fans going into the crucial part of the season.

Harper will be hoping his Year 7 team can bounce back from a recent 3-2 league defeat to Archers as they head into the final 2 weeks of the season sat in mid-table. Wins against London Academy and St James would almost certainly guarantee them a place in the play-offs, a performance which would ultimately judge Harper's first season in charge as a success. Harper will be hoping his side can build on their recent demolition of the Year 8 'B' Team in a hotly-contested friendly fixture.

Having last tasted victory back in the first week of September, Aberdeen legend Tom Holt will be hoping his Year 10 team can finish the season strongly with back to back victories against London Academy and St James. With Recoe Martin having recently joined up with the England squad, Holt will be hoping the young midfielder can inspire the team to a top 4 finish. Having finished 1st in the league and suffered semi-final heartbreak last season the pressure is on Holt to inspire his team in the coming weeks.

Despite suffering 3 successive league defeats, it is still mathematically possible for Richardson's Year 11 squad to make the play offs if they record back to back victories against St James and Bishop Douglas. Onlookers will be hoping a recent change in playing personnel and tactics will kick start this talented group of player's season.
