Hendon School 100th Anniversary Sponsored Walk

Dear Parent/Carer,

As a part of our 100 year celebration, we are holding a sponsored walk. This walk will take place on the 17th of July during the school day. It is a part of the Capital Ring Walk (Map of route below), Highgate to Hendon, although we will be leaving from Hendon to walk to Highgate and returning to Hendon for lunchtime where a normal school lunch will be provided. Students will have the choice of a 5 mile (2 hours) or 10 mile (4 hours) walk. We would like all Year 9, 10 and 6th form students to join us on the 10 mile walk. Students will be asked to get sponsorship for this and all money will go towards the school's enrichment fund, helping to pay for activities that happen outside of the classroom for our students.

This is a great opportunity for the school to celebrate together and our students to spend some fun, quality time with each other and our staff. **YOU ARE WELCOME TO JOIN US, PLEASE INFORM ME VIA EMAIL BELOW OR ON THE FORM ATTACHED TO THE LETTER YOU WILL RECEIVE IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO GET SPONSORS AND WALK WITH US.**

All students are expected to take part and special provision will be made for those who, for valid reasons, cannot take part or complete at least 5 miles. **A letter will be coming home with a permission form attached. Please can you ensure that this is returned to school. If you do not receive a letter please contact me at school.** The walk will start from school and return there before the end of the school day. Students will be expected to register at the normal time, and need to bring please:

- A water bottle with water in it.
- Appropriate clothing for the weather (a waterproof top would be very advisable).
- Sun Tan lotion.
- A snack to eat on the way.
- A hat.
- Shoes that are old, comfortable and will not cause blisters. **NO HIGH HEELS OR NEW SHOES PLEASE.**
- A rucksack or bag to hold these items in.

We are aware that the walk falls within Ramadan, as such if your child is fasting we will be offering a shorter walk and a school-based activity. Please let us know of this by indicating on the form to be sent home if you would like you child to be involved in this option.
