Travel Health

We have been asked by Public Health England to remind anyone planning on travelling overseas this year to seek health advice from their GP 6-8 weeks before they travel. This is to help minimise children and their parents acquiring infections abroad and becoming unwell on return to the UK. Where vaccinations are required, most are provided free by the NHS.

There is a particular risk for families visiting certain countries including Pakistan, India, Bangladesh, Ghana and Nigeria as these are countries from which we see high numbers of travellers returning to the UK unwell with travel related infections. Many of these infections are particularly serious for children. For example, 1004 children under 10 years of age and living in London, caught malaria between 2000 and 2012. For some infections, such as hepatitis A, typhoid and paratyphoid, a child may need to be excluded from school for a significant period of time to prevent transmission to other children so disrupting their education.
