



Hendon School is a safe school. We are currently working with students to ensure that they understand what this means and that they feel safe, and students have completed a work shop on this. It is important that we also remind parents/carers of this too, we ask that this is discussed at home with your son/daughter.

As part of our commitment to Keep Hendon Safe we work with the Metropolitan Police. Like all schools in London we have a school police officer. PC Maddi supports the students and staff, as well as delivering sessions on personal safety and your rights and the law.

As a school we also have agreed to support the police in preventative measures to reduce knife crime. As part of this initiative, we have scheduled Knife Arches on the school premises on an *ad hoc* basis. We have done this for the last four years and have never had any weapons found. As a school we are also able to bring drugs dogs into school. Clearly, the dates of any Knife Arches or dog visits are not published, as the rationale behind these is that the students do not know when they are scheduled in advance.

School staff can also search students for any item banned by the school rules. Items include: weapons, alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco and lighters, fireworks, stolen items, phones and electronic devices and any items likely to be used to cause offence. School staff, also have the power to use reasonable force to prevent students committing an offence, injuring themselves or others and damaging property.

We know the vast majority of parents/carers are fully supportive of these initiatives as they are focussed across London trying to keep young people safe. Thank you for your continued support.

Please come and support this event. Tickets are available to purchase in advance online through Parentmail and are also available on the door. The cost of food is included in the ticket price.

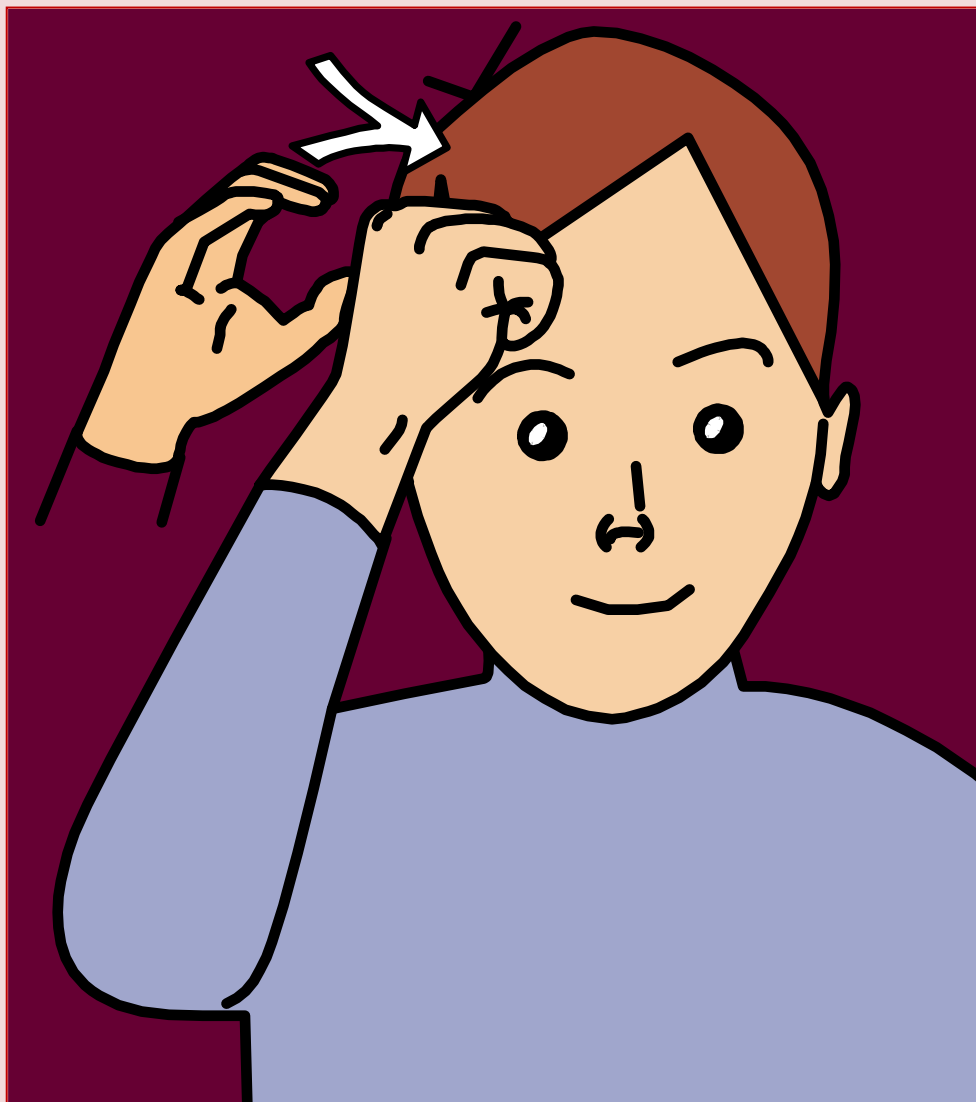
