Yr 9 PSHE day – Community Day

Our next PSHE day is on Tuesday 12th November. The Year 9's will be completing a series of community and citizenship activities during the day.

Students will have the opportunity to hear from a number of speakers on the idea of making a positive difference to their local community. Two of the speakers will be talking about the Citysafe campaign, which the students have previously learnt about and this is now their opportunity to do some work on this issue. The students will also conduct some research in the local community completing questionnaires with local residents and speaking to local shop keepers about the Citysafe campaign.
