





Chidi's Achievements

Working in Barnet, we have promoted the various Wates programmes including the Summer Residential to local schools and organisations. We are proud to share that three Barnet residents were selected for this highly sought-after opportunity, including Child Olisa from Hendon School, who has excelled both during the program and in a subsequent internship on the prestigious Bishop's Avenue project.

Chidi first participated in the Summer Residential, where she was one of 30 students in completing a series of practical and theoretical construction tasks, alongside teambuilding and communication activities. Hor enthusiasm and skill during the residential set her apart as a dedicated and proactive learner.

Following the residential, Chidi was invited to a participate in a three-week paid internship with Wates, working on our renowned project at 56 Bishop's Avenue. During the internship, she shadowed both the commercial and design teams, contributing to their daily tasks and gaining hands on experience. This exposure helped Chidi discover new roles in the construction industry that she hadn't previously considered.

Chidi also took the initiative to sign up for the Wates Girls Academy, a five-month mentorship program designed to support young women in exploring different areas of construction. 


Pathway 2:
